

“ To Michael's childhood family: I feel so sad for your (our) loss - of a son, brother, brother-in-law, uncle, DEAR FRIEND, etc... who had the biggest heart of gold of anyone that I have ever known. Michael was very much like a brother to me - and although he frequently commented to me about how proud he was of my accomplishments and of our friendship - I can honestly say that these feelings were always VERY MUCH reciprocal - and I often told him so. Our childhood friendship started before we began kindergarten - and we spent a great deal of time together (our mom's were long-time friends as well). After the Detroit riots - and my parents moved ONE WHOLE MILE AWAY (to Oak Park - a couple of years before the Finks did too), we strayed a bit socially (meeting Caryn probably also contributed to that process too). As I pursued my path to college, medical school and beyond. Michael pursued his work as a painter and became a true artisan as a contractor and designer. While we all face struggles in our lives (like Michael's and my spinal issues) - with a tremendous amount of love and support, Michael and his family fought his non-spinal issues and drug dependence valiantly. His move to California (in the 90's) with the help of Chabad was TRANSFORMATIVE in his life. He seemed to thrive in the beautiful LA climate - and he was so proud of his work. I'm so glad I had a chance to spend time with Michael 10 years ago we we both turned 50. I took a trip there with our middle son Jeff - who turned 21 the same month that Michael and I turned 50. Michael picked us up in a Jaguar from the Los Angeles airport - and showed around for a couple of days before Jeffrey and I took a 2200 mile RV trip - that Michael did not join us for. He took us to several of his job sites - and even introduced us to one of his customers - actress Moon Bloodgood. Though Michael didn't join Jeff and I on the RV trip, he DID however join us for a couple of days celebrating our significant birthdays together afterwards in Las Vegas. Since we had driven to Vegas in the RV (and Michael flew there from LA), we were able to pick him up from the airport (and reciprocate) - but not in a Jaguar - but rather with our only available mode of transportation - the 26 foot RV. Now for those who know Michael well, he was at times a bit grandiose - and he seemed to take particular joy in getting picked up by a 26 foot Limousine (that had pictures of several national parks on the sides) at the Las Vegas Airport.

Michael was also very proud of his adult family; He frequently told me about the joy he felt after meeting and falling in love with Anita - and then becoming a part of her family - as a step dad and grandfather to her children and grandchildren. He was especially happy for the opportunity to help facilitate Anita's first return trip to the Philippines to see her family several years ago, but then I felt sad that his last few years were marked by pain and sorrow (his feeling disappointed that he couldn't do more to helping Anita to be reunited with her kids - but I can say that Michael poured his total effort into every one of his endeavors - both with work and with his family. I feel grateful that Michael was a part of so many significant events in my life (Bar Mitzvah, wedding, bris of our first son, our daughter's wedding, my Mom's funeral and shiva). I thank Hashem for putting Michael's and my lives on a parallel and I pray that the warmth of our memories and the laughter that Michael brought into everyone's lives who knew him can sustain those feeling without his physical presence. My life was much better - that Michael Fink had a place in it - than it would have been without him at all.
