“ Our friend Ave (Avrami@aol.com) had a prodigious memory, fondness for people, love of learning and yidishkeit and the yiddish language. Born in a hassidic family he related how the Nazi's(yemach shemo) tried to humilate Jews. But his father told him he had to resist them.

He was loyal and trusting. He told of a time when his friend, Jack Kutnic, casually sought funds for a business deal & the two agreed on a simple handshake. No contract was needed.

In a sample of his powers of memory, Avrami could daven for the amud (lead the daily prayers) without referring to a sidder (prayer book). And even in his infirm last years his memory served him well.

Last week I told Esther, my wife, "I'm going to the One Stop Kosher store to pick up some things and to see Abe Pasternak". On Fridays Abe could be seen at One Stop in his wheel chair parked near the check-out while his assistant was buying things for him. After exchanging a few words he would always ask, "How's Esther". This last friday I didn't see Abe. Then we got the news that he was nifter. He will be missed.
