Age 90, of Farmington Hills, died August 7, 2011.

Born in Peekskill, N.Y. on October 1, 1920, the son of Alexander and Bertha Klein Woodell. Mr. Woodell graduated Cum Laude from New York State College for Teachers at Albany (now known as SUNY) in 1942, with a degree in mathematics. He was elected to Kappa Phi Kappa, a honorary educational fraternity.

He served in the army, including a tour of duty in Korea from September 1942 - June 1946 as a meteorologist and retired with the rank of Captain.

Mr. Woodell then attended the University of Michigan from 1946-1948 and received a M.S. in mathematical statistics.

For over 35 years, he worked in the automotive field with the last 25 plus years with Ford Motor Company. He also worked evenings for over 30 years as an adjunct professor of Statistics at Wayne State University and Oakland University.

A member of B'nai B'rith, his hobbies include carpentry, flower gardening and an interest in archaeology. He also served as a handicap patrol volunteer with the Farmington Hills Police Dept.
