Age 89, of Charlotte, NC. She was born on October 6, 1926 in Chelm, Poland to Pinchos and Brandle Feldman, the oldest of five children.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her two husbands, Morris Bankirer and Alexander Altenhaus; brother, Harry Feldman and an infant sister.

Celia is survived by her sons, Harold (Carol) Bankirer of Huntsville, NC and Robert (Marcia) Bankirer of San Jose, CA; grandchildren, Sarah (David) Tyre of Monroe, NC, Matthew (Leslie) Bankirer of Mooreville, NC and Nathaniel (Rabbi Sarah Shulman) Bankirer of Northridge, CA; great-grandchildren, Parker Tyre, Ellery, Levi and Holden Bankirer, and Lielle Bankirer; sister, Esther (Bill) Icikson of West Bloomfield and brother, Ray (Mina) Feldman of Farmington Hills; nieces, Leah Trosh, Marilyn Yarbrough, Jessica Feldman and Pamela Feldman; nephews, David Icikson and Eric Feldman.

As the eldest child, Celia was instrumental in the survival of the family as they were caught up in the Holocaust, spending years on the move and in a slave labor camp. eventually making their way from the far east back to Central Europe and into the American zone of occupation. Following time in a Displaced Persons Camp in occupied West Germany, Celia, her husband Morris and son Harold immigrated to the United States. Later she was able to

bring her parents to the United States, followed by her brothers and sister. Celia raised her sons in Michigan, lived in New York and Florida, finally settling down in West Bloomfield. In her final days, she lived near her son, Harold and his family in North Carolina area. Celia was a member of Congregation B'nai Moshe and a life member of Hadassah. She had the voice of an angel and served with enthusiasm and joy in Temple choirs wherever she lived. Her zeal and love of family will always be remembered.
