“ I first met Charlotte and Herb in the early 1990s when I befriended their daughter Jeanette and son Gary in Fort Worth, TX. I had just moved there for my first job out of school. Now meeting your friend’s parents when you are in your early 20s is not necessarily something you jump at. But when I met Char and Herb, I knew I was in the presence of two gentle souls quietly making this world a better place.

A few years later, I moved to New Jersey and the Feldmans took up residence down near Norfolk VA. Now with a wife and small kids in tow, we journeyed down to the Tidewater area visit Char, Herb, Gary and Jeanette. Already a young parent myself, I took notes and observed with awe and respect as Char and Herb demonstrated the textbook definition of caring, doting parents. Although I was only on the periphery of Char’s life, she and Herb treated us with gentle kindness like we were members of their family. They always listened intently after inquiring about the latest successes and failures in our lives. And we always left our visits well fed. I remember she was an avid swimmer who took good care of herself, but only so she could give of herself to others. A dear cousin of mine, who was a Holocaust survivor passing away also within the last year, wrote a poem with a title that says it all: *You Only Have What You Give Away*. Charlotte mastered this and gave all of what she could of herself to support her loving husband, kids and friends.

I know she enjoyed retirement in Corpus Christi. A part of me was always saddened that she was so far away though where I couldn’t get just a few minutes every now and then to live in the shadow of her shining example. Our time together was fleeting. Even today, years after I last saw her, when I am faced with weighing life’s dilemmas, she is, and will always remain one of the voices in my head helping to show me the way. May her memory be a blessing for her kids and the better world she left.

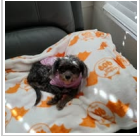

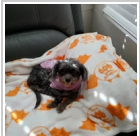

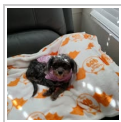
