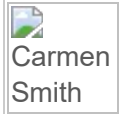

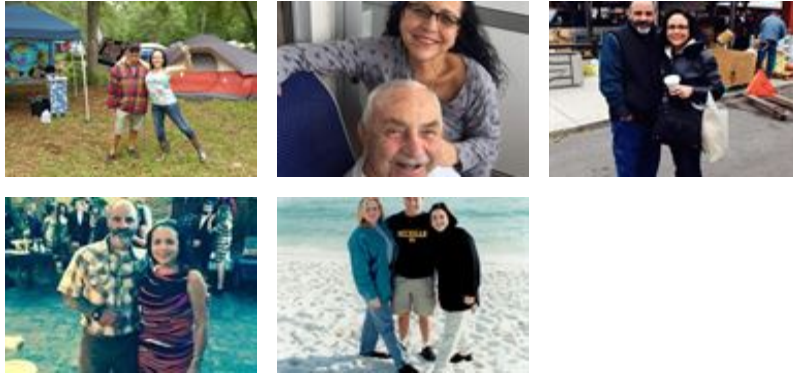

Her heart had suffered so much these past 2 years. I only hope that she found peace in death.

I had known Debbie for 19 years. She had been doing my hair that long. We talked a lot over the years about family and kids and the issues we each had.

Debbie was such a giving person. So, it was only natural that I help her with money and clothes when she lost everything in the flood. I went to Kyle's trial with her and took notes while she was sequestered for pretty much the whole trial. I sat with her on the courthouse lawn afterwards and tried to keep her legs covered since she was wearing a dress. I sat with her on the lawn while she cried and was absolutely beside herself. I went to her house one day when she was upset.

But, the one thing I didn't do for her was convince her that life was worth living. I wish I had done more for her.

I saw her on Valentines Day at the salon. My son called me while I was there and I put him on speaker phone and the 3 of us talked. Debbie said she felt like he was with us as we talked. My son loves to talk and so did Debbie. I knew if I had an appointment at the salon at 1:00 it would be 2:00 before she would start on my hair. It never bothered me. I enjoyed our time together.

She was so excited at Christmas to exchange gifts. She gave me a necklace that said "I am thankful that in God's design he planned it so your path crossed mine". I am wearing it now so she can be close to my heart. I had already found a bracelet to give her for her birthday. I will keep it and wear it myself so I can think of her when I wear it.

My last memory of her is when I had lunch with her and her dad the day after Valentines Day. We sat in La Hacienda for about 4 hours. We ate and then went over notes from Kyle's trial so she could be ready for the appeals attorney the following week. When we got ready to leave we hugged and kissed and she said "I love you and I can't thank you enough for all you have done for me". I told her I loved her too and that I was only doing something that a friend would do for a friend.

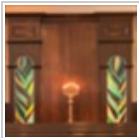

She will forever be in my heart.

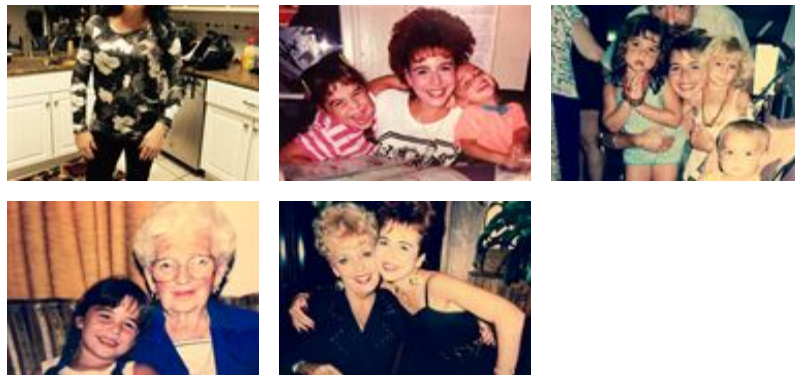
