“ I will always remember Dr. Krakauer for saving my thumb on my right hand back in 1958 when I was in high school. I was working at a summer job in a ball bearing factory when a stamping machine misfired and chopped off a good sized piece of my thumb. The company's insurance clinic was going to amputate it but, due to a delay at the clinic. I was sent to the hospital where the good doctor was working.

I was in high school at Sacred Heart Seminary in Detroit at the time with the intentions of studying for the priesthood. When Dr. Kraukauer heard this he was very concerned and told me that he would save my thumb. He did a marvelous job in doing this. I never did become a priest but I still have my thumb. I was years old 17 at the time and on June 28th of this year I will turn 80 years old. Every time I look at my thumb I remember the caring doctor who saved it. I'm sure there is a special place in heaven for him, There always has been in my heart.
