“ I served together with Reuvain Mordechai on the executive committee of Yeshivat Akiva and at Young Israel of Southfield. He was always ready to share some new insight he learned especially those of Chasidus.

For a year or two Reuvain Mordechai made the announcements of coming activities at the end of Shabbat morning services. I remember one of our fellow congregants describing his announcements as a "Scream". He inserted such humour into his announcements that we frequently found ourselves doubled over with laughter.
