Age 99, died February 6, 2018

A World War II army veteran, he was active with his Regiment Alumni Association of the 143 Infantry. Throughout his life, he was a Scout Master, a member of the Pleasant Lake Community, a life time member of the Masons, a member of Temple Israel, a volunteer with World Medical Relief and was on the Livonia Housing Commission. He was also active with the American Jewish Congress and taught at Wayne State University and was the president of the Oak Park School Board. An expert on Marble and Mausoleums, he helped build mausoleums for the Archdiocese throughout the country. He also helped build Michigan State University, University of Detroit and University of Michigan. He was known by all to be "A NICE GUY".

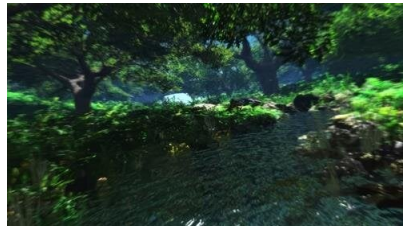

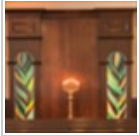

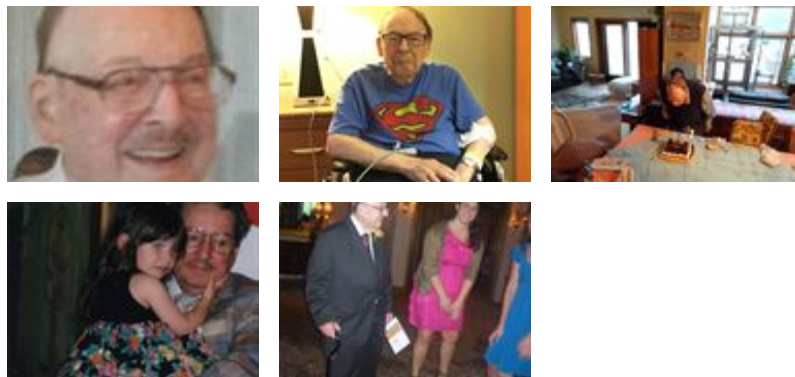
