



## EUGENE FELDMAN

Eugene Feldman, 95, passed away peacefully at home on December 2, surrounded by his loving family.

Born in 1930 in Glinka, Poland, Eugene was a Holocaust survivor who endured the forests of Belarus during World War II, losing many beloved family members. After emigrating to the United States, he was drafted into the U.S. Army, serving from 1949 to 1953. Because of his remarkable command of multiple languages, he was stationed in Europe throughout his service. Eugene was well known in the community as the co-owner, with his brother Michael, of Dexter Davidson Kosher Meats.

He was a devoted father to Rhonna (William) Nelson and Robin (Michael) D'Angelo; a loving grandfather to Matthew Lenzi (Julia Simon), Jason Lenzi, and Jacob Wilson; and a dear brother to Michael Feldman and Bella (Paul) Brookenthal. He was the cherished son of the late Pinches Feldman, the late Rifvka Feldman, and the late Chava Feldman.

Eugene will be deeply missed by his many nephews, nieces, great-nephews, great-nieces, extended family members, and the countless friends who loved and admired him for the extraordinary person he was.
