He joined the Navy as soon as World War II began. He graduated from the University of Illinois while in the Navy and went on to become an officer in the Navy Reserve. It was during this time he married the foundation of his future life, Shirley Marks.

He founded and established Crystal Auto Parts in Dearborn in the early 1950s. He believed in the value of hard work and went to work at Crystal Auto Parts until he was 95.

He loved to tell jokes, laugh and share his laughter with others. Music and singing were central to his family life.

He will be sorely missed by those who knew him.

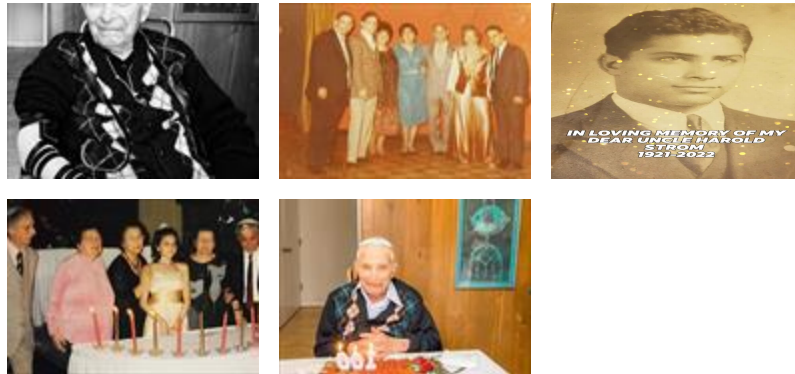
