Mr. Sherberg died November 8 at the age of 90.

A Holocaust Survivor, he was born in Demblin, Poland on June 10, 1922. His parents who were both born on the same day in 1900, were married in 1919. His father died November 11, 1943 in Maidanek in Poland. His mother along with his sister and two brothers died on May 6, 1942 in the gas chamber in Treblinka. His sister, Paula, married her first couzin, Mosze Roter, on May 5, 1942. The day before she was taken to the gas chamber in Treblinka. During World War II, from 1939-1941 Harry was in a forced labor camp in Demblin, Poland. 1940-1941, he was in Yanishup. 1941-1942 in Straflager, Poland. 1942-1944 forced labor camp in Demblin. 1944 Czenstochau labor camp. 1944-1945 Buchenwald Concentration Camp. Harry was in a Death March to Golditz and Theresienstadt and was finally freed in 1945 from Theresienstadt.

Mr. Sherberg became a member of Sheerit Hapletah.
