



## HOWARD LOUIS SHORR

Age 73, of Oak Park, died April 10, 2013.

A retired Captain of the Air Force, Mr. Shorr was an intelligence officer with the 401st Tactical Fighter Wing and was presented many awards including the Distinguished Flying Cross, 3rd Oakleaf Cluster and the Air Force Commendation Medal for hazardous duty. As an Electronic Warfare Officer, on October 5, 1965, he provided reconnaissance and support for strike forces in North Vietnam. With disregard for his own personal safety, he flew his unarmed aircraft deep in hostile territory contributing greatly to the success of an important mission. The professional skill and airmanship displayed by Shorr reflected great credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.

A member of Jewish War Veterans, he loved books, remote control airplanes and model cars.

The funeral service will be held at Hebrew Memorial Chapel.
