“ *Something today made me think of Mr. Siegel, so I googled his name and found that he passed over two years ago. I used to work at Howard's Discount on 8 Mile and Van Dyke as a teenager in the 80's. When Mr. Siegel came into the store I was always terrified that he would come stand by me and watch me give change. Much like teenagers today, we couldn't seem to figure out how to give change without looking at the machine for the answer and Mr. Siegel would have none of that! He would cover the amount and make us count the money back to the customer. At the time it scared me to death when he did that, but I practiced it, over and over. I used it many times at other jobs over the years, I almost never looked at the what the machine said, I just counted the money out the way Mr. Siegel taught me. As an adult, I would do the same to my kids. If we stopped for fast food I would quiz my kids, our bill is \$8.45, I gave her a \$20, how much change should we get back? They'd have to give me the answer before I got up to the second window. So thank you Irving Siegel, for teaching me a valuable lesson so many years ago! May you Rest In Peace.*
