Age 89, of West Bloomfield, died January 25, 2013.

IRVING STOLLMAN

A dreamer, artist and inventor, he loved classical music, jazz, art and reading. He served as a veteran in the armed forces.

Mr. Stollman was a creator ahead of his time. Whether it was designing a shopping cart that would unload the groceries on the check out line without breaking an egg in the early 60's, or designing and building low income housing made out of a Tyvek in the 70's, he was able to make the ordinary seem and look unordinary, and, more often than not, special. In the early 90's he was looking into ways to provide heat for apartments through renewable energy and designed a geo-thermal heating system. He loved to tinker with electronics and toy cars and trains. After his wife died in 2010, he moved to Jewish Senior Life Meer Apartments where he was referred to as "the artist". He spent his remaining time shmoozing with his new friends, sculpting and listening to operas and musicals.

He was trusting and hopeful whether in business or his personal life, always giving people the benefit of the doubt and assuming the best.
