He was treated kindly by Mona-the heart and soul of Panera-who greeted every customer upon recognition by their first name. He knew Michelle, a team leader. He was treated warmly by officer Upshaw, known by his nickname of Rock. He knew Dennis Clark-AKA -Buffalo, that was where he was from. When asked how he was doing he said "better know." He was tight with Charles Pitts, nicknamed Dr. Pitts. He knew Harry Todd. An attorney who was a F-14 pilot, who is never wrong and never makes a mistake. He was friends with Kathlene Mcnellis, who attended his funeral. She visited Jeffrey several times at Medilodge. Jeffrey would always watch Fox 2 so she could see her son Michael Estime do the weather.

The good Steve took his car to the carwash with Jeffrey. He watched the good Steve wash and dry the car. The good Steve said "why didn't you get out of the car and help me?" Jeffrey said "I was the coordinator."

Even Brian's son, Nathan visited him multiple times. Brian would do many errands for Jeffrey, getting things for him and taking him shopping. One time Jeffrey called Brian and asked for his assistance on an errand. Brian said he could not do it because he was in Indiana. The good Steve also took Jeffrey for his errands. He is in the video of the funeral wearing a black hat and his dress shorts. The other Steve (not a bad person) but the polar opposite of the good Steve did not want Jeffrey sitting next to him. If Jeffrey would sit at the table next to him, the other Steve would be so nervous he would start shaking. The good Steve would refer to the other Steve as the Zohan or a shmoehawk.
