I, Michael Weiss, the husband of Lilly Weiss have tried to write down the history of my wife which was heartbreaking to do.

I never thought it would be under these circumstances.

Born in 1930 to Lenke and Ignantz Weiss in Hungary. She mentioned this many times during her life. Her mother was put into the Ghetto by Hungarian Nazis and was holding the little hands of 2 young sons, George and Joseph. It was the last time, Lilly saw her mother and siblings. She was transported to

Auschesleben and worked in an airplane factory with her sister Edith all through the Holocaust.

In 1945, with G-d's help, she was rescued. Her sister got married and had 2 sons. Lilly then got married to her brother-in-laws brother, Michael Aranovich and had children, George and Eva.

May her name be as a blessing.

Age 90, died January 5, 2021.

A Holocaust survivor,

Beloved wife for 35 years to Michael Weiss.
