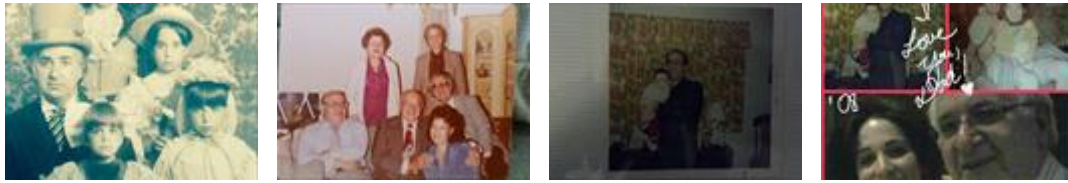

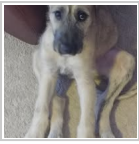

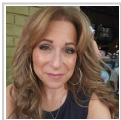


“ Meredith,

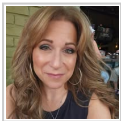
