Age 69, of West Bloomfield, died April 6, 2023.

A child of Holocaust Survivors, he lived on an egg farm with his family. He went to Boston University and then travelled to Israel and received a law degree from Bar Ilan. He lived in Israel for 8 years and in 1990, he married his beloved Alison. Working for Israeli Bonds, he also became a substitute teacher at Farber Hebrew Day School, helped during lunches and volunteered for the entire school system. He also volunteered with Bais Chabad of West Bloomfield, working his way through first as a board member, past treasurer, past vice president and becoming president of the Shul. A serious Torah student, he was also a born teacher in any environment. He loved classical music and had a great, quiet and quick sense of humor, especially loving funny t-shirts.

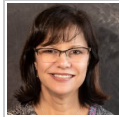
