Age 99, of West Bloomfield, died June 19, 2016.

A WW II veteran, Dr. Green was a captain and was a part of the first wave that liberated Buchenwald Concentration Camp.

A founder of Congregation Beth Moses, he also was the "acting" Rabbi for a number of years.

Meyer eventually became an officer of Young Israel of Oak Woods. A dentist, he also participated as the past president of several dental associations, including the American Board of Oral Medicine.

Loving grandfather of Ashley (fiancé, David Murav) Stoneman.
