She founded a Judaic Needlepoint group that she started at home and had several of her works published in books. She was also one of the founders of the Needle and Textile Guild of Michigan which is still a viable organization. She was very active in politics and testified in Lansing many times on a variety of issues.

A volunteer at Sinai Hospital, she found herself in the Jewish News numerous times.

A Phenomenal cook, she was very social and entertained all the time. Natalie had one of her cakes featured in Bon Appetit magazine.

Above all, her greatest joy was being a grandparent.
