Age 86, of Bloomfield Hills, died October 31, 2021.

Born in Morocco, Pinhas was an orphan at a young age with very little in this world. He worked hard to build himself up from nothing. After being taken to Israel by a Jewish organization, he joined a kibbutz in Israel, Hafetz Haim, where he studied Judaism. He joined the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) and worked his way up to Lieutenant Colonel. One of his proudest life accomplishments was designing the Israeli tank, the Merkava. During his time at the IDF, he worked hard to be accepted into the Technion in Haifa, Israel, where he got an advanced degree in engineering.

Pinhas and his family moved to Detroit, Michigan in 1979 so that he could pursue a Ph.D. from Wayne State University. Pinhas became a tenured professor at General Motors Institute (GMI)/ Kettering University where he had a long career of over 25 years. Throughout his career, he became a world-renown expert in his field of mechanical engineering, suspension design, and dynamics. He also wrote several textbooks in his field.

Pinhas loved the State of Israel, soccer (futbol), James Bond movies, and all types of music. He was a gentle, loving, emotional, and optimistic person. He was a natural fighter and persevered through numerous challenging medical conditions. He always found the good in people and looked for peace in difficult situations. Even during his sickness, nurses and doctors were amazed by his humor and optimism.

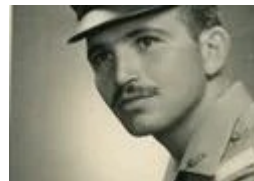
