One year we found a used train set at a charity auction. I was not even sure it was the same set but it looked the same. As soon as we gave it to him, he tested the engines right away and when they were working he got very excited. I did not realize how hard it was to keep the engines running. I am not sure he kept anything else from the set but the two engines had him very excited. I do remember going to several of his concerts. Finally, I remember how he liked to research stocks and discuss them. If you ever asked him about a stock his face would light up and you were in for a half hour conversation. For years after I grew up I would enjoy discussing stocks with him. Ray will be greatly missed. It hurts me to not be there for his family at this difficult time. I am stuck in a cruise ship in the Pacific and cannot be there. My thoughts and prayers are with you.
