Age 95, of Oak Park, died February 13, 2011.

The Funeral Service will be held at Hebrew Memorial Chapel.

A Social Worker with Jewish Family Services, Mrs. Feuer worked with the resettlement and Restitution Department and still assisted Holocaust survivors till just a few months ago.

With a deep connection with Israel, she was a past board member of the Michigan chapter of the Israel Cancer Society, a past officer of A.P.I (Americans for Progressive Israel), a former member of the Detroit Labor Zionist Organization, the Detroit Zionist Federation. She was also a member of B'nai B'rith, a life member of Hadassah, a member of the Jewish Community Council Board and the Grey Panthers. She sang with the Metropolitan Chorus(which started as the Don Frohman Chorus).

Mrs. Feuer was honored as 1 of 5 Vatikot by the Zionist Movement and also was honored for 8 Over 80 by Federation. She was a 60 year member of Temple Israel and the Temple Sisterhood.
