Rosa Krasman, 98, of West Bloomfield died Nov.12, 2023..

She was born and raised in Rafalovka, Poland to Jacob Leib and Bella Blizniuk and was the youngest of 8 children. Happy childhood memories were abruptly cut short by the advent of the Nazi invasion and subsequent atrocities of the Holocaust. She and 2 siblings were the only survivors of her large family. After the war, she met and married another survivor, David Krasman, and together, emigrated to the United States. Despite their horrific wartime experiences, they created a warm, joyful, and "balbatish" home for their 2 sons, Manus and Gary and, later, for her seven grandchildren and nine great grandchildren whom she all loved and adored.

Rosa was very health conscious and walked with her beloved husband, David, most days well into her late 80s. She was an avid reader, an amazing cook and most importantly loved being with people. She always made the home welcoming to neighbors, friends and relatives who enjoyed her company and wonderful cooking. She was active in B'nai Brith as well as

other Jewish causes.

She is survived by her sons and daughters-in-law, Manus and Barbara Krasman, Gary and Shelley Krasman; grandchildren, Michael (Erin), Stephen (Karen), Danielle (Adam), Zachary (Nikolas), Jamie, Noah and Ethan; great-grandchildren, Chloe, Reid, Dean, Josie, Liam, Lake, Ronen, Norah and Jonah.

She was preceded in death by her beloved husband, David Krasman.
