Rose was happiest when she was surrounded by all of the kids. In addition to her family legacy, Rose also recorded and published a diary, "Remember Never to Forget," about her experience in the Holocaust. She is a survivor, and made her family promise to never forget about the Holocaust, and to make sure that her story was told

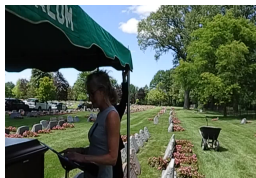
