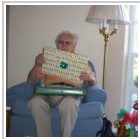
Mr. Colman is survived by a world of loving extended family members and friends.

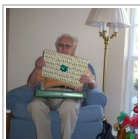

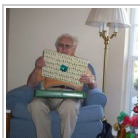

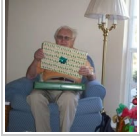
