Age 93, of Southfield, died March 17, 2017.

An active participant in the community, Mr. Havis was the past president of the Southfield City Zoning Board, the Building Authority and the Planning Commission.

He was also a past president on the Oak Park Zoning Board and held positions there with the Building Authority and the Planning Commission. Past President of Hebrew Benevolent Society in 1987 and 1988, he was also chairman of the Building Maintenance Committee, the Hebrew Memorial Park Cemetery Maintenance Committee and was a very active board member from 1967 to 1988.

A member of B'nai B'rith, Masons and Shriners, he participated with Meals On Wheels with the National Council of Jewish Women.

He received the first Citizen of the Year Award from the City of Southfield.
