Stuart belonged to many singing groups. He often invited me to join him in those groups, especially when audition periods occurred. Unfortunately, I was over-booked in my musical life and had to decline. Except in one instance when I joined the Golden Choraliers with him. To this day I give thanks to Stuart for connecting me with that wonderful organization.

When Stuart initially had me accompany him, he would provide me with shards of paper that included the title and lyrics to various songs he wished to perform. Needing sheet music with which to accompany him successfully, I identified his vocal range and developed actual sheet music with which to support him. This compendium of music grew significantly over time, as Stuart was not one to repeat any song too many times. With this book, I visited him in hospice and sang a number of his songs to him, a cappella (often out of tune, of course). I marvel that Roberta and other family members holding vigil in that hospital room allowed me to make this humble presentation to my friend. I thank them.

“ I met Stuart in 2017 when he auditioned for a role in a play called "This & That" (aka: TNT) with the Original Heart Of The Hills Players (HOH), a community theater group that required all participants to be over 50. Sometimes we wondered if Stuart was over 50 years old because of his ability to embrace being a kid again. Stuart was featured in a comedy skit sketched around the song "Tip-Toe Through The Tulips". Stuart joined the men of the cast to sing and dance a stately Gavotte while dressed in tutus. By itself, it was funny. But Stuart raised it to a new level by his unique style of dance.

Stuart asked me to accompany him in many of his presentations at various senior living places. He had a flare for singing songs, and he often invited me to join him in song, especially the humorous songs or songs with easier harmony. Notably, Stuart would engage the audience members, ask them their names and thereafter call them by name as he performed. He prided himself in making friends. He was a loving, out-going man.
