“*Mr. Fischer was a kind-hearted, good man who will be greatly missed by all who knew him. Joseph was a Holocaust Survivor who was born in Timisoara, Romania. His parents were Eugene and Fani. His parents and Joe survived but his uncles, cousins and extended family were all murdered. Joe was a young boy who was in hiding from the Germans with his mother during the war. He stated that he lived in constant fear of danger, fearing that they would be captured by the Germans. Joe's father was in a forced labor camp. The family came to Canada in 1960 and then later moved to Detroit in 1969. Joe worked as an accountant/bookkeeper and was also in sales. Joe's message to future generations was, "I hope that there will never be another Holocaust. I think our people suffered enough. Never forget."*
