Almost 50 years ago, Sarah and Joey Bricker were chosen by the Ribono Shel Olam, to be the caretakers of a very special and precious Neshama. Or if we want to follow the wisdom of some of our great Rabbis and thinkers of long ago (and also the thinking of certain secular scholars), we may say instead, that just prior to the conception of Chaim Zev HaKohayn, his precious Neshama was informed by Heaven that its human form was going to present its parents and its family with challenges not yet widely known to humanity.
